## On-Campus Game Day Covid-19 Protocols Fall 2020

- **The Tucson Unified School District will not allow spectators at any events.**
- **All parent/guardians that provide transportation to the Student/Athletes, must always remain in their vehicles. Please do not exit vehicles for any reason.**
- THMS is following all TUSD Interscholastic and AIA protocols and procedures for any athletic events on the Tucson High Campus for the 2020 – 2021 school year.
- THMS is working on a streaming option for parents. We apologize in advance if streaming services are not available at the time of any specific event.
- THMS will adhere to all individual sport modifications sent out to member schools by the Arizona Interscholastic Association.

### Requirements – THMS Hosting Contests

- All THMS Student-Athletes, Coaches, Managers, Staff, Officials, and event workers, will be required to have their daily COVID Screening completed and have their temperatures taken prior to entering the THMS Facility.
- All Officials, Coaches, Staff, and event workers must remain in face coverings/masks (covering both mouth and nose) for the duration of the contests.
- As per AIA Volleyball Modifications – Only the Student-Athletes on the court may remove their masks. All other individuals in the facility must always wear a mask.
- Visiting Coaches, Student-Athletes, Managers, and Officials will adhere to the following:
  1. Submission of Roster to THMS AD or Athletic Trainer prior to entering the facility of all people present and that have cleared screening procedures.
  2. Required temperature check – Thermometers will be provided to the opposing school for their coach or administration to conduct on the THMS Campus. Only students and Coaches with temperatures of 99.9 or below will be admitted. Individuals with a 100 or higher temperature will be allowed a 5-minute cooling down period before retesting. Any person with a second temperature reading of 100 or higher will not be admitted into the facility and will be asked to be sent home.
  3. No use of locker rooms or dressing facilities will be allowed. THMS Administration and Athletics Staff ask that all Student-Athletes, Coaches, and Officials arrive dressed prior to the contest. Restroom facilities will be available, and we ask that only one person use the restroom at a time. Restrooms will not be used as locker rooms or changing areas.
  4. Visiting Student-Athletes, Coaches, and Officials will be held to the same guidelines and protocols of the AIA for sport specific modifications. This includes all TUSD and THMS Guidelines and Protocols. Failure to adhere to any guidelines and protocols will result in the specific individual Student-Athlete, Coach or Official being removed from the facility.

## Visiting Teams Entering and on the THMS Campus

- Visiting team remain in bus or car until notified by their coach to enter the screening facility.
- Visiting team will be escorted to the screening facility (East Gym) by THMS Admin, AD or Monitor when the whole Team has arrived. Team will enter the screening facility in single file line and remain socially distanced, at least six feet separation.
- Visiting team coaches will be allowed time to screen student-athletes in the screening facility. Thermometers will be available for the Visiting Team Coach if needed.
- Once all Visiting Team Student/Athletes are cleared, they will be escorted to the West Gym in a single file line while remaining socially distanced, at least six feet of separation.
- Visiting team coach will provide THMS AD, Admin or Athletic Trainer with roster of cleared Student/Athletes, Managers, and Coaches.
- Once Visiting Team is in the West Gym, any nonplaying student-athletes will stay in the assigned bleacher section and remain socially distanced, at least six feet apart in the bleachers.
- All Student-Athletes, Managers, Coaches, and Officials must always wear masks.
- Upon completion of match, visiting team will be escorted in a single file line into parking lot or bus bay by THMS AD, Admin or Monitors while remaining socially distanced and wearing masks. The exit will via the southeast hallway doors of the West Gym.

## In Match Protocols

- Bench Area:
  - Bench/seats will be placed in a staggered formation in rows with a minimum of 6 feet between seats/rows.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available at each bench. Athletes are encouraged to sanitize their hands frequently, including between games.
- Scorer's Table:
  - Seating limited to the individuals working the official score book, score board operator, libero tracker, and AD/Admin. Seats will be staggered.
- Ball Rotation:
  - Ball rotation workers will wear gloves and masks. A 3-ball rotation will be utilized rotating after each play.
  - Balls will be wiped down with a TUSD approved cleaning solution and towels.
- Line Judges:
  - Line judges will wear masks.
- Water:
  - **Everyone must bring their own personal water bottle. WATER BOTTLES OR CUPS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED.** A designated individual wearing mask/face covering and gloves will refill athletes' personal water bottles following TUSD's Infectious Disease Protocol.
- **Concessions – THERE WILL BE NO CONCESSIONS AVAILABLE AS PER TUSD GUIDELINES**

## **Requirements – Tucson Badger Volleyball School Away Contests**

- All THMS Student-Athletes, Managers, and Coaches are required to transport themselves to all competitions. The Parent/Student Travel Forms must be submitted to the Coach prior to the day of competition and must be signed by an Administrator.
- **All Parent/Guardians that provide transportation to the athletes, must always remain in their vehicles. Please do not exit vehicles for any reason.**
- **For NON-TUSD hosting Schools and Districts, Parents/Guardians or anyone providing the student transportation to the competitions are expected to follow all guidelines and protocols of those host Schools and Districts.**
- All Student-Athletes, Manager, and Coaches will be required to have their Daily COVID Screening on the ATS portal completed and have their temperatures taken upon arrival at the away contest, prior to entering the hosting facilities.
- THMS Student-Athletes, Managers, and Coaches are expected to comply with all requests of the hosting school and district regarding COVID-19 Guidelines, Policies and Protocols.
